Old Swinford Hospital - GCSE and A level results 2023

Against a backdrop of tighter, more stringent examination grade boundaries and a decline in the percentage of top grades being awarded nationally, we are very pleased to see that across the board, our GCSE results are in line with or exceeding our pre-pandemic attainment trends.

Old Swinford Hospital is a school that constantly strives for academic excellence and these results demonstrate the commitment of our staff and students, in partnership with parents, to secure the very best outcomes.

We are particularly pleased with our performance in core subjects (98% securing 4-9 in Maths and 92% 4-9 in English Language or Literature) and in Science (96% 4-9 combined and 100% in triple). We know that the grades attained in these subjects often form the crucial foundations to further education and future opportunities.

Another highlight of this year's results is the percentage of students achieving the very top grades. Old Swinford Hospital is considerably ahead of national averages in 7-9 attainment. Whilst nationally there has been a significant decline in the number of top grades being awarded, Old Swinford Hospital has bucked this trend and actually added to its 7-9 tally (179 top grades awarded) compared to the last set of fully validated pre-pandemic results (172 awarded).

As we continue our journey to become a fully co-educational school, we are excited to see how we can continue to go from strength to strength in terms of our GCSE outcomes.

We are also delighted that this year has seen some of our best outcomes in terms of Sixth Form destinations. Just some of the many highlights include four of our students progressing to Oxford or Cambridge Universities to study History, Biology, Chemical Engineering and Engineering.

As well as a significant number of our leavers achieving places at Russell Group universities, we also have students who are pursuing exciting and highly competitive Higher Level and Degree Apprenticeships in fields such as data analytics (Jaguar Land Rover), broadcasting (Sky News) and commercial banking (HSBC). We are very proud of what our Sixth Form leavers have achieved and wish them all the very best in their future studies and employment.
