Uniform and Equipment

School Uniform

The School's [Behaviour Policy](#) sets out the Dress Code applicable to all students. As with all aspects of school life the School has high standards and expectations for uniform however we have a duty to make sure that the uniform we require is affordable, in line with guidance from the Department for Education on the cost of school uniform.

We understand that items with distinctive characteristics (such as branded items, or items that have to have a school logo or a unique fabric/colour/design) cannot be purchased from a wide range of retailers and that requiring many such items limits parents' ability to 'shop around' for a low price. Accordingly, we have limited the number of such items in the dress code and where possible we try to avoid different uniform requirements for different year groups and houses.

We also realise that we suggest you obtain certain quantities of some uniform items, PE/games kit and bedding. This is to allow for time for items to go through the laundry, especially where students are boarders. We have tried to limit this, particularly where goods are branded. The OSH Shop, sells pre-loved uniform and sports kit, including the branded blazer and sportswear. It is perfectly acceptable to buy uniform and kit from the OSH shop and many parents do.

We do however require all boarders' bedding (duvet, blue duvet cover and pillow case set, and white fitted sheet) is purchased from our nominated supplier, as it is made to measure specifically for our beds, and all duvets are of a Proban treated cotton-covered fire-retardant material.

Full details of school uniform, including sports kit, are sent to all parents when their child is to be admitted to the school together with a copy of the Behaviour Policy.

Students are expected to wear the correct school uniform at all times excepting where informal dress regulations or specified, approved, non-school uniform days apply. This means that students are expected to wear uniform whilst:

- On the school premises
- At out-of-school events or on trips that are organised by the school, Open Mornings, concerts and other such activities or where they are representing the school.

Informal dress regulations apply after 4pm on Monday to Friday and throughout the weekend, unless the student is put in detention, when full School uniform must be worn. Unless authorised, full school uniform will also be worn when students go to town during the week or when requested by the member of staff in charge of the activity.

Students attending sporting clubs and activities after school-hours must wear the correct kit as stipulated by the member of staff in charge of the activity.

This document sets out, for general information, a list of clothing comprising day wear and sports kit as well as items for boarding use, where they can be purchased and whether items are compulsory or optional.

Don't forget to label uniform and PE/games kit, to assist in re-uniting pieces of clothing with their owners when mislaid.

Outside of the school day

Boarders must keep an appropriate amount of clean, smart and presentable informal clothing in School and store it under the direction of Matrons and Housemasters.

School suppliers

Dancers, Halesowen

Official school sports kit is supplied by Ron Flowers Sports, who are based in Wolverhampton. Items can be purchased direct from their shop or via their website www.ronflowerssports.com.

OSH Shop

The OSH Shop is located in Swinford Court, by Reception and offers good condition, pre-loved uniform and PE kit at a fraction of the original price. It is run by volunteer parents and all of its profits are donated back to school. Remember to visit us when you're tackling the task of buying uniform. It carries some sports kit, and aims for a wide range of sizes, but is of course dependent on what it receives as donations. It is also growing its Sixth Form supplies and, as the community of girls grows it will also hopefully increase its stock of girls' clothing.

The OSH Shop is a cashless outlet and instead accepts card payments or BACS transfers.

Other school clothing

All clothing items marked generic can be purchased from any appropriate high street/online outlet on the condition they meet the School's dress code. Please note that if optional items, that are marked as school branded, are to be worn then they must be items of school uniform and not other brands

Sport mouthguards

If students are participating in either Hockey or Rugby in School they will, in the interest of safety, require a mouthguard as part of their compulsory kit. The School work with OPRO, who are the largest manufacturers of Custom-Fit mouthguards in the world. OPRO have launched their revolutionary Instant Custom-Fit mouthguard which is a dentist level mouthguard that can be fitted at home. Links to purchase via OPRO will be provided in the joining instructions.

Whilst we are providing this opportunity through OPRO we are happy for pupils to have mouthguards from other suppliers. Mouthguards are available from various suppliers at a range of prices. They do vary in quality and the level of protection they offer.

Name tapes

Name tapes are essential items for all students and must show not only the students' name but also their Boarding House. These can be supplied by Dancers, and both Dancers and Ron Flowers Sport offer naming services. Please contact the suppliers directly to discuss. Alternatively, you are welcome to use another provider.

Overseas students

Suppliers offer a delivery service for all school uniform to parents/guardians of overseas students only, as they may experience difficulties in visiting their shops. Please contact suppliers directly and as soon as possible to discuss your requirements. They can also arrange for name tapes to be sewn into clothing purchased from them, for an additional cost.

Alterations

Dancers offer an alteration service whereby garments can be amended to fit as required. Please contact Dancers directly for prices and information.
